Item to bring....

Field items

- Notebook
- Pencils
- Geologic Hammer (try and borrow one if you don't own one)
- Hand lens (if you own one)
- Sample bags (zip lock freezer bags work well)
- Water bottle
- Olsen paper (assigned reading) and Field Trip Guide

Clothing

- Boots (necessary for days 1 and 2)
- Sneakers/sandals (for the 3rd day)
- Cool-weather clothing
- Warm-weather clothing
- Rain gear (waterproof jacket or poncho at a minimum)

Other

- Packed lunch (for first day—we won't be stopping)
- \$\$ for food and other amenities (how much depends on if you will be eating in restaurants or buying groceries)
- Camera
- Hat and sunscreen (hey, we might get lucky)
- Other comfort items

Try and pack your items into one smallish bag (to be stowed in the back of the van) and one small daypack (to keep near you and in the field).
